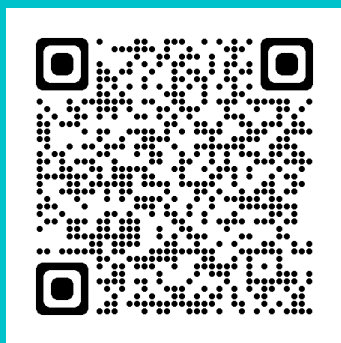


Suicide Prevention© (SP)

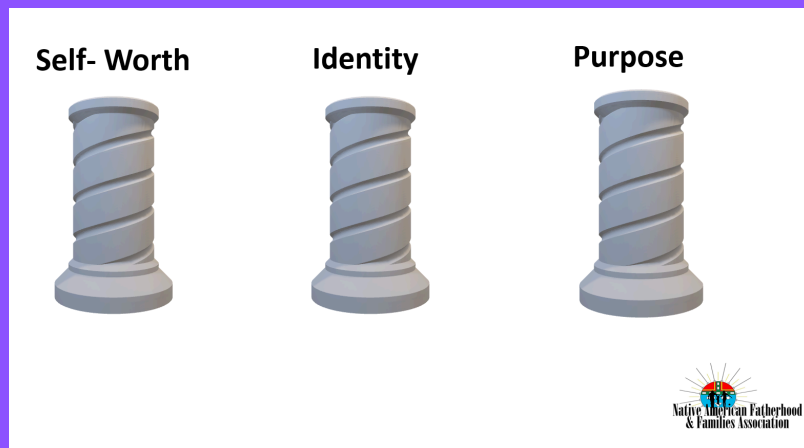
