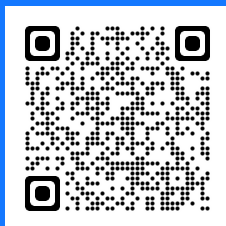


# Fatherhood Is Sacred<sup>®</sup>, Motherhood Is Sacred<sup>®</sup> (FISMIS)
