Native American Fatherhood and Families Association (NAFFA) began in 2002 in the Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community with just one father facilitating group sessions. Working to build up attendance, NAFFA's founder Albert Pooley developed the curriculum Fatherhood Is Sacred® Motherhood Is Sacred® using his knowledge as a Native American, father, husband, and his experience as a Marriage and Family Therapist.

Since that time, NAFFA's programs have spread through over 300 tribes across North America. NAFFA's programs have been used in criminal justice, state aid programs, human services, treatment centers, education, and many more programs, agencies, and services.

Native American Fatherhood and Families Association's mission is to strengthen, keep, and reunite families by responsibly involving fathers and mothers in the lives of their children, families, and communities. Native American Fatherhood and Families Association, an Arizona-based 501c3 non-profit organization, strengthens families through four curricula: Fatherhood Is Sacred® Motherhood Is Sacred® (FIS/MIS), Linking Generations by Strengthening Relationships®, Addressing Family Violence & Abuse© and Suicide Prevention© curricula.

All curricula use time-honored cultural principles and practices as a foundation to build strong families that are resilient to divorce, domestic violence, substance abuse, suicide, and human trafficking. The result of these programs has been an increased awareness of the sacred purposes of families with strengthened relationships and communities. Over 60,000 parents have enrolled in local chapters and 2,200 facilitators have been certified to teach the FIS/MIS curriculum across the US and Canada.


